

**Trion**  
**8 Tower Bridge**  
**161 Washington Street**  
**12<sup>th</sup> Floor**  
**Conshohocken, Pa. 19428**

**From Center City Philadelphia:**

- Take I-76 (Schuylkill Expressway) WEST / VALLEY FORGE
- Take Exit 332, CONSHOHOCKEN (old exit 29)
- Stay in the right lane as you exit the ramp and approach the first traffic light (Front Street/Route 23)
- Pass straight through the traffic light, then cross the bridge in the right lane.
- Turn right on the first street over the bridge -- E. ELM STREET
- Turn right on the first street after Elm -- HARRY STREET
- Cross over railroad tracks, then turn right onto Washington Street
- Turn left into the first driveway EIGHT TOWER BRIDGE - 16-story office building located at Washington and Harry Streets.

**From King of Prussia and West:**

- Take I-76 (Schuylkill Expressway) EAST
- Take Exit 331B toward PA-23 CONSHOHOCKEN
- At the traffic light at the end of the off ramp, turn right onto Matsonford Road and proceed to the first traffic light (Front Street/Route 23)
- Pass straight through the traffic light, then cross the bridge in the right lane.
- Turn right on the first street over the bridge -- E. ELM STREET
- Turn right on the first street after Elm -- HARRY STREET
- Cross over railroad tracks, then turn right onto Washington Street.
- Turn left into the first driveway EIGHT TOWER BRIDGE - 16-story office building located at Washington and Harry Streets.

**From Allentown and points North:**

- Follow the Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-476/old Rte. 9) South to Exit 20 – Mid County Interchange (old exit 25).
- Follow signs to I-476 South. Continue on I-476 South to Exit 16 - Valley Forge (old exit 6).
- As you exit, stay to the right and follow signs for Route 23 - Conshohocken.
- At the traffic light at the end of the off ramp, turn right onto Matsonford Road and proceed to the first traffic light (Front Street/ Route 23)
- Pass straight through the traffic light, then cross the bridge in the right lane.
- Turn right on the first street over the bridge -- E. ELM STREET
- Turn left into the first driveway EIGHT TOWER BRIDGE - 16-story office building located at Washington and Harry Streets.

- Cross over railroad tracks, then turn right onto Washington Street.
- Turn right on the first street after Elm -- HARRY STREET

**From Harrisburg/Pittsburg and points West:**

- Follow the PA Turnpike (Rte 276) East to Exit 24 (King of Prussia) to I-76 East toward Philadelphia.
- Follow signs to Exit 331B - Plymouth Meeting (old exit 28B). As you exit, follow signs for Route 23 - Conshohocken.
- At the traffic light at the end of the off ramp, turn right onto Matsonford Road and proceed to the first traffic light (Front Street/ Route 23)
- Pass straight through the traffic light, then cross the bridge in the right lane
- Turn right on the first street over the bridge -- E. ELM STREET
- Turn right on the first street after Elm -- HARRY STREET
- Cross over railroad tracks, then turn right onto Washington Street
- Turn left into the first driveway EIGHT TOWER BRIDGE - 16-story office building located at Washington and Harry Streets.

**From Delaware and points South:**

- Follow I-95 North to Exit #7
- Merge onto I-476 North via exit# 7 toward Plymouth Meeting
- Continue on I-476 North to Exit 16A towards PHILADELPHIA / PA-23 / CONSHOHOCKEN. Stay to left when exiting to follow ramp towards Conshohocken.
- At the traffic light at the end of the off ramp, turn right onto Matsonford Road and proceed to the first traffic light (Front Street/ Route 23)
- Pass straight through the traffic light, then cross the bridge in the right lane.
- Turn right on the first street over the bridge -- E. ELM STREET
- Cross over railroad tracks, then turn right onto Washington Street.
- Turn right on the first street after Elm -- HARRY STREET
- Turn left into the first driveway EIGHT TOWER BRIDGE - 16-story office building located at Washington and Harry Streets.

Visitor parking in front of building and on first floor of parking garage across from building. Trion is located on 12<sup>th</sup> floor.
